

#### Same or Different?


Level: Pre-intermediate - Advanced

Timing: 20 mins

**Resources:** Whiteboard and a copy of the A & B worksheets for each pair of trainees

Language: Exact descriptions

**Plan:** Draw pictures on the board as below. Bring attention to Side A, Picture 1. Ask the trainees to describe the picture.



### Help them by giving phrases:

It's a ...

There's a ... in the top corner

It looks like a ...

In the middle there's a ...

Now ask trainees to describe Side B, Picture 1. Ask if they are the same (yes, they are).

Next, ask trainees to describe Side A, Picture 2. Then Side B, Picture 2. Ask if they are the same (no, Side A has 5 hairs but Side B has 6 hairs).

Put the group in pairs, A and B. Each pair should sit opposite / facing each other. Give out the A and B worksheets.

#### Rules:

- 1. Speak English only
- 2. You cannot show your worksheet to your partner
- 3. You cannot draw shapes in the air

Trainee A describes Picture 1. Student B listens and asks questions. They must decide if their pictures are the same.

Trainee B then describes Picture 2. They continue until all pictures have been discussed. Finally, they look at each other's worksheets to see how many they guessed correctly. There are 18 pictures. Set a time limit of 18 minutes.
